## Club Guidelines for students' training and progression in Karate-Do

### New Students

- Minimum age 6 yrs.
- Junior students (6-14 yrs) may train Saturdays 2-3pm and Wednesdays 6-7pm.
- Senior students (15yrs +) may train Saturdays 2-4pm and Wednesdays 6-9pm.

### Martial Arts Licence

- **Students must have applied for a martial arts licence within 6 weeks of commencing training at Worcester Wado-Ryu. Failure to do this will result in denial of training until a properly completed application is received by the Club.**

### Badge Gradings

- Badge gradings will be held every four weeks where possible.
- Three badges are to be taken per grade by all students up to and including 4<sup>th</sup> kyu (purple belt).
- Badges must be worn by all students up to the age of 14.
- Senior students are to take the badge gradings but are exempt from wearing the badges.
- Previous badges must be worn before a student can attempt their next badge.
- Generally only 1 badge to be attempted within any 4 week period, with the exception of 10<sup>th</sup> kyu (white belt).
- Badges to be taken and passed the correct order.
- Badges are 60p each when purchased from the club.
- All badges are to be attached to the left sleeve of the do-gi jacket.

### Belt Gradings

- Belt gradings will be held every three months where possible.
- To qualify and take their first and subsequent gradings students must have applied for a licence or have a renewal in process.
- Students must have passed all three badge grades and attained the required number of grading points.
- Grading points are awarded for lessons, courses attended and competitions entered.
- Generally the grading is held from 3-5pm on Saturday, instead of the normal intermediate and advanced lessons. The 2-3pm beginners' lesson is replaced by a practice lesson for all those registered to grade.
- The grading fee is £10: this includes the certificate, belt and official endorsement of the student's licence, and the practice lesson that precedes the grading.
- Students on holiday or unwell on grading days may be permitted grade on another convenient date.
- Only Worcester Wado-Ryu students are permitted to watch the grading tests; parents and friends who do not train are regrettably not allowed in the grading room.
- After each grading the results are sent to the Wado Academy, where the certificates are made-up and returned to the club for presentation to the students.
- The student will always be the first one to hear of their result: the result will not be given to any parent, guardian or any other person prior to the student.
